

Call for Interest:

Amendments to IEEE 802.16.2 (Recommended Practice for Coexistence of Fixed Broadband Wireless Access Systems)

IEEE 802.16 Session #12

12-15 March 2001

The IEEE 802.16 Working Group on Broadband Wireless Access has completed a Working Group Letter Ballot of Document IEEE 802.16.2/D2-2001 (“Recommended Practice for Coexistence of Fixed Broadband Wireless Access Systems”). Several Working Group participants have suggested the need for extensions to this document. This Call for Interest provides notification of the intent to hold a meeting on this topic at 802.16’s Session #12. It also requests input on possible topics for an amendment to 802.16.2. This work could lead to the creation of a Study Group chartered to write a PAR to authorize work on an amendment. The amendment could encompass more than one topic. Some that have been suggested are:

- Extensions suitable for operations from 2-11 GHz
- Coexistence with point-to-point systems

Contributions of suggested topics for an amendment, along with suitable motivation, are welcome for presentation at Session #12. Contributions will be considered non-confidential and will be posted for public access on the 802.16 Web Site <<http://ieee802.org/16>>.
