Dear Ms. Gorman:

In accordance with Clause 5.9 of the IEEE-SA Standards Board Operations Manual, I would like to request an Interpretation of IEEE Recommended Practice 802.16.2 (“Recommended Practice for Coexistence of Fixed Broadband Wireless Access Systems”).

Subclause 6.1.3 (“Out-of-block unwanted emissions”) of IEEE 802.16.2 presents a block-edge mask. Figure 7 (“Example of application of unwanted emission limit”) and the associated text could be read to imply that a single-channel emission mask corresponding to the transmitted spectrum in the figure is a requirement. I do not think that this was intended.

Can you please clarify the intent of the recommended practice on this topic?
