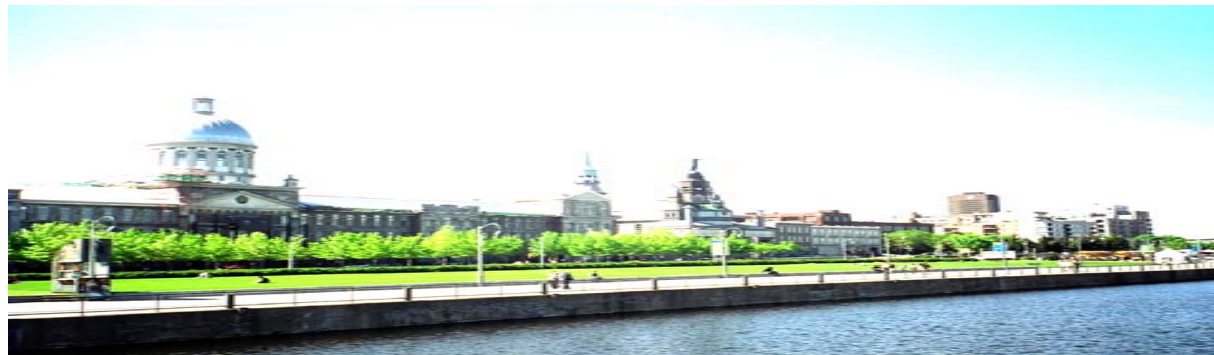

From P.E. Trudeau (Dorval) Airport (YUL) to Delta Centre-Ville



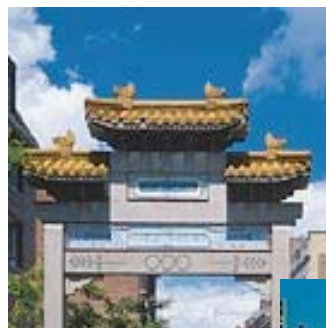
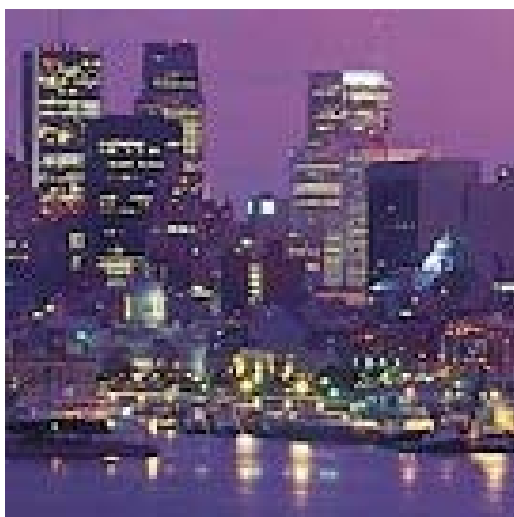
- Take Highway 20 East
- Follow signs to 20 East towards Montréal (Centre-Ville)
- Stay in the middle lane and follow signs to 720 East Montreal Centre-Ville.
- Once on 720 East (elevated expressway), keep right and take Exit #4 (Rue De La Montagne – Rue St-Jacques)
- Keep left in the exit and follow the sign to De La Montagne Nord.
- Turn right on St-Antoine (first light)
- Drive to the 5th light and turn right on Square Victoria
- Turn right on St-Jacques (first light)
- The hotel access ramp is on the right side, just before University Street

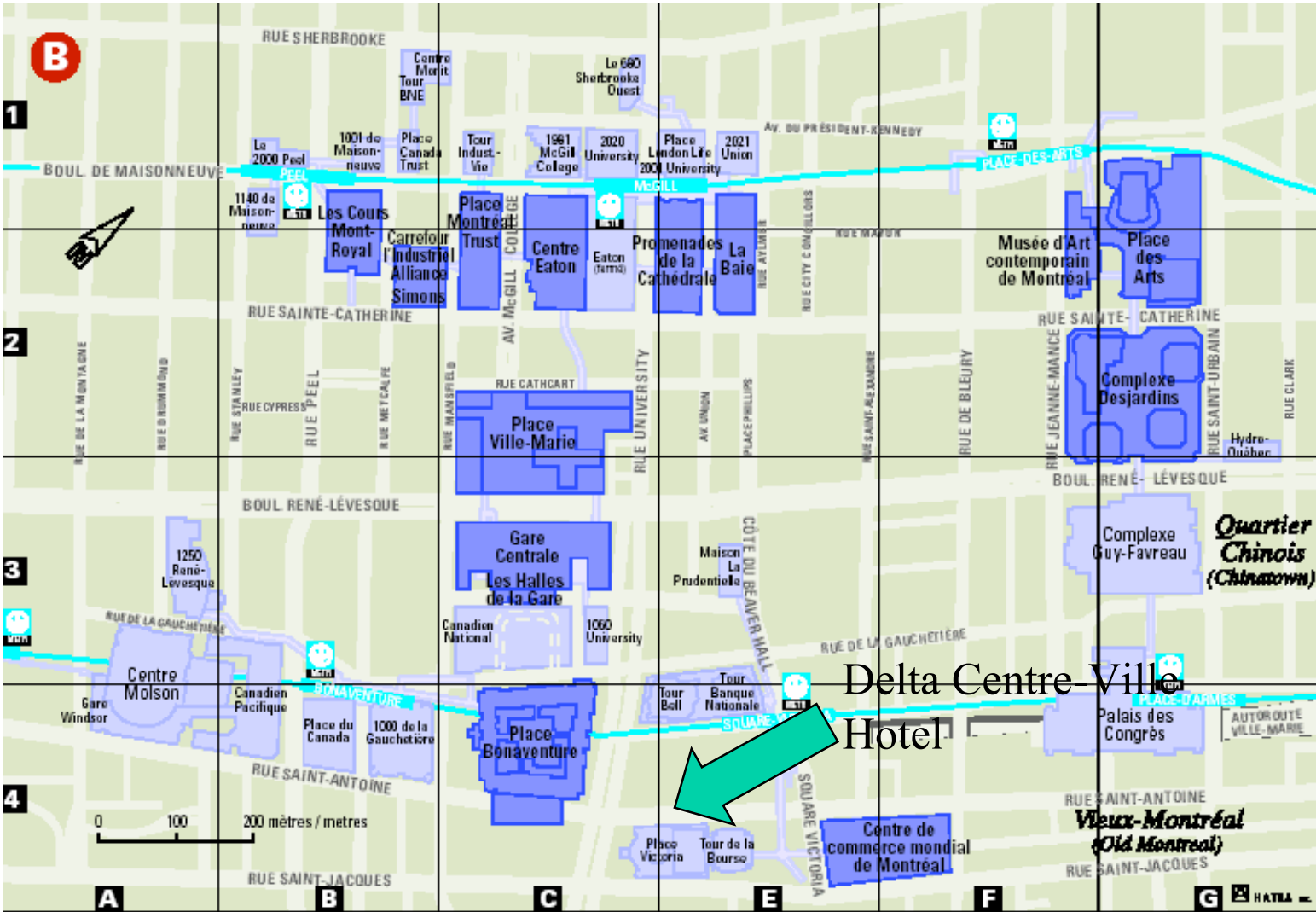
