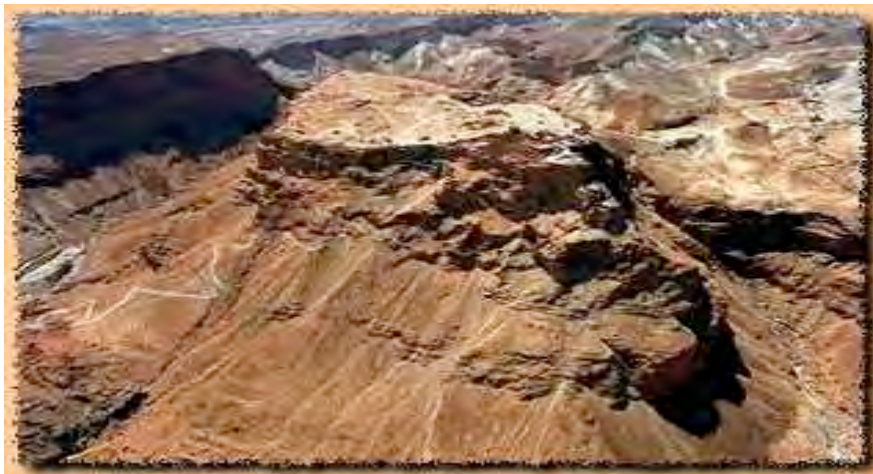

# Who needs a visa?



- **Do NOT need visa residents of countries: EU, Canada, Japan, Korea, Singapore, Australia and the USA**
- **HOWEVER, if born in one of the countries: Iran, Iraq, Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Egypt, Tunis, Morocco, Malaysia, Indonesia, Mauritania, Eritrea, Somalia, Qatar – you DO need a visa**
- **Residents of China, India, Thailand, Romania and Africa DO need a visa**
- **If there is any doubt, we advise you to fill the questionnaire and send it to us**

# Procedure for people needing a visa



- **Please fill in the form “Application for entry visa”**
  - Attach a photo
  - Make a photocopy of your passport
- **Send us the form and the photocopy (preferably by emailing a scan)**
- **Alvarion will submit the application forms to the Ministry of Internal Affairs in Israel and have it approved**

# Procedure for people needing a visa (2)



- **If there is an Israeli embassy in your vicinity - after receiving the visa approval from the Ministry, we will inform you that an embassy has received a notification regarding the approval**
  - At this stage you can approach the embassy (either yourself or via your travel agent) and get the visa in your passport
- **If there is no Israeli embassy in your vicinity – we will send you a special visa approval by a fax which you'll need to present at the border control**
- **The visa-approval-by-fax procedure can be used in special cases that you do not want the entry visa to appear in your passport**
- **The visa approval is submitted by you to the passport control person in the airport, and you may ask that your passport is not stamped**
