The IEEE 802.16 Working Group (WG) on Broadband Wireless Access\* acknowledges receipt of your letter (numbered [IEEE L802.16-04/09](#) of 13 March 2004) and the Technical Report "Service & Network Requirements for 2.3GHz Portable Internet" (numbered [IEEE L802.16-04/10r1](#)). We appreciate this input and your willingness to share it with us.

At its Session #30 this week, the IEEE 802.16 WG approved comment resolutions in the ballot of IEEE P802.16-REVd/D3, a revision of existing work on fixed broadband wireless access. We expect to complete this document by mid-May. We also resolved comments on P802.16e/D1, the enhancement for support of mobile terminals. Substantial progress was made, and the work remains on track for completion later this year. We welcome your comments on the upcoming P802.16e/D2.

Finally, we would like to inform you that the Working Group accepted an invitation to hold its Session #33 in Seoul, Korea in September 2004, with the dates yet to be finalized.

The IEEE 802.16 Working Group appreciates TTA's interest in our work and activities.
