TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE CORRESPONDENCE GROUP FOR IMT-ADVANCED EVALUATION

1

2 The Correspondence Group will be held in the period between 6th WP 5D meeting and 8th WP 5D
3 meeting as a tool to augment communication and to facilitate the evaluation work of WP 5D and the
4 Independent Evaluation Groups on the candidate IMT-Advanced technologies.

5 The Correspondence Group will be available for ITU-R Members, designated representatives of the
6 proponents of candidate technology submissions and designated representatives of the Independent
7 Evaluation Groups. Participation by the proponents and Independent Evaluation Groups is
8 encouraged but is not mandatory.

9 The following three Topics will be established.

- 10 - Topic 1 for the technology submissions in Documents IMT-ADV/4, IMT-ADV/5 and
11 IMT-ADV/7 (IEEE technology)

12 This Topic is to facilitate better understanding of the Independent Evaluation Group on
13 the specific technology submissions in Documents IMT-ADV/4, IMT-ADV/5 and
14 IMT-ADV/7, e.g., with questions by Evaluation Groups and answers from proponents
15 as well as comments from other participants.

- 16 - Topic 2 for the technology submissions in Documents IMT-ADV/6, IMT-ADV/8 and
17 IMT-ADV/9 (3GPP technology)

18 This Topic is to facilitate better understanding of the Independent Evaluation Group on
19 the specific technology submissions in Documents IMT-ADV/6, IMT-ADV/8 and
20 IMT-ADV/9, e.g., with questions by Evaluation Groups and answers from proponents
21 as well as comments from other participants.

- 22 - Topic 3 for dialogue among the Independent Evaluation Groups

23 This Topic is to facilitate communication among Independent Evaluation Groups on
24 matters that are not addressed in the other Topics.

1 **Period of the Correspondence Group activities**

2 The kick off date of the Correspondence Group activity is as soon as after the 6th WP 5D meeting,
3 and the closing date of the Correspondence Group activity is June 2, 2010 which is the deadline for
4 the Independent Evaluation Groups to provide final evaluation report.

5 **Administrative aspects**

6 The proponents and Independent Evaluation Groups are requested to provide details of those
7 designated representatives towards the Correspondence Group and its Topics. These representatives
8 will be granted read and write access, and a right to copy the information which is provided in
9 Correspondence Group for the internal work of the proponents and Independent Evaluation Groups
10 in these matters. ITU-R TIES registered users would have read only access. Oversight and
11 administration of the Correspondence Group would be under the purview of the convener of the
12 Correspondence Group and Counsellor of ITU-R SG 5.
