

Call for Comments on draft IEEE Contribution toward Recommendation ITU-R M.[IMT.RSPEC]

Deadline: 03 January 2011 AOE

The IEEE 802.16 Working Group's ITU-R Liaison Group is drafting an IEEE contribution to ITU-R Working Party 5D as an input to the working document towards PDNR ITU-R M.[IMT.RSPEC], which includes an overview and detailed specifications of IMT-Advanced radio interface technologies.

The draft contribution on IMT.RSPEC provides the text for the following two Annexes:

This Call for Comments requests comments on Annex B.1 only. In addition to reviewing the text, we seek views on ways to reduce the number of pages of the document, as the current text is about 25 pages long even though ITU-R anticipates about 10 pages.

Comments should be submitted in contribution format, showing mark-ups to the above document as necessary.
