
### 1 Motivation for the Changes

Due to some mistake during previous presentations the sentence “\* Apply to OFDMA only” has been

moved closed to the name of the figures, so it seems that figures apply to OFDMA only. Because the figure are valid both for OFDM and OFDMA the sentence “\* Apply to OFDMA only” has to be moved away from the name of the figure in order to remove ambiguities.

The sentence “\* Apply to OFDMA only” means that the specific transition into the diagram applies to OFDMA only.

**Figure 70a – Network entry state-machine BS side.**




Figure 70b – Network entry state-machine MS side.
